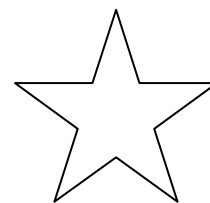


**“March Madness Chess Party”

The March Madness Chess Party hosted by Liberty Christian Chess Tournament is a **K-12** tournament with the following divisions: K-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-12, (**subject to change**). Each participant will play in all five rounds (Swiss System pairing), using a Game/30 format (i.e., each player has 30 minutes to complete their moves resulting in a maximum game duration of 60 minutes). Individual grade trophies and team trophies will be awarded. K-6 Elementary students who receive 3.0 points qualify for the State Elementary Chess Championships. **Entries limited** to the first 200 paid participants.

The entry fee is \$12.00 (\$6.00 each additional child from the same family.) **100% pre-registered and prepaid!** Online registration is preferred, through www.chesschampions.org. Payment is made online through Paypal. Payments may also be sent to the school. If registering by mail, payment must accompany the registration form below and be **postmarked no later than Monday, March 9th**.
